ENTRY -- Hamilton Anxiety Rating Scale (HAM-A)

ELEMENT --

CLUSTER -- Q1. Anxious mood

ELEMENT -- Worries, anticipation of the worst, fearful anticipation, irritability

CLUSTER -- Q2. Tension

ELEMENT -- Feelings of tension, fatigability, startle response, moved to tears easily, trembling, feelings of restlessness, inability to relax

CLUSTER -- Q3. Fears

ELEMENT -- Of dark, of strangers, of being left alone, or animals, of traffic, of crowds

CLUSTER -- Q4. Insomnia

ELEMENT -- Difficulty in falling asleep, broken sleep, unsatisfying sleep and fatigue on waking, dreams, nightmares, night terrors

CLUSTER -- Q5. Intellectual

ELEMENT -- Difficulty in concentration, poor memory

CLUSTER -- Q6. Depressed mood

ELEMENT -- Loss of interest, lack of pleasure in hobbies, depression, early waking, diurnal swing

CLUSTER -- Q7. Somatic (muscular)

ELEMENT -- Pains and aches, twitching, stiffness, myoclonic jerks, grinding of teeth, unsteady voice, increased muscular tone

CLUSTER -- Q8. Somatic (sensory)

ELEMENT -- Tinnitus, blurring of vision, hot and cold flushes, feelings of weakness, prickling sensation

CLUSTER -- Q9. Cardiovascular symptoms

ELEMENT -- Tachycardia, palpitations, pain in chest, throbbing of vessels, fainting feelings, missing beat

CLUSTER -- Q10. Respiratory symptoms

ELEMENT -- Pressure or constriction in chest, choking feelings, sighing, dyspnea

CLUSTER -- Q11. Gastrointestinal symptoms

ELEMENT -- Difficulty in swallowing, wind abdominal pain, burning sensations, abdominal fullness, nausea, vomiting, borboyrngi, looseness of bowels, loss of weight, constipation

CLUSTER -- Q12. Genitourinary symptoms

ELEMENT -- Frequency of micturition, urgency of micturition, amenorrhea, menorrhagia, development of frigidity, premature ejaculation, loss of libido, impotence

CLUSTER -- Q13. Autonomic symptoms

ELEMENT -- Dry mouth, flushing, pallor, tendency to sweat, giddiness, tension headache, raising of hair

CLUSTER -- Q14. Behaviour at interview

ELEMENT -- Fidgeting, restlessness or pacing, tremor of hands, furrowed brow, strained face, sighing or rapid respiration, facial pallor, swallowing, etc.
