## **Auto Logout Configuration**

## Overview

This process will explain how to set the Auto-logout time within the Medical-Objects Explorer (Meridian). This is the period of time the Explorer client will wait before logging you out.

## Configuring the Auto-Logout Duration



While it is possible to do this, Medical-Objects does not recommend changing the value as it can cause security risks.

1. With your Explorer software logged in, Go to View, and select Configuration.

2. On the left of the window that opens select **PGP Configuration.** The following window should appear.
